








#### EAST MAUI RAINFOREST HIKE



#### GO WITH THE FLOW

This tour allows you to explore the Hawaii Volcanoes National Park and Hilo's waterfalls in flight and on foot. This adventure departs from the Kona International Airport in an executive style Bell 407 helicopter. En route to the volcano area, you will overfly the world-famous Kona coffee district and skirt three of Hawaii's towering volcanoes: Hualalai, Mauna Kea and Mauna Loa.

Upon arrival to Hawaii Volcanoes National Park, your pilot will search out the day's activity – sometimes a burning forest fire, a stream or lake of glowing lava, or an entry into the ocean – often only accessible by air. After the first part of your air experience, you will land at the Ka'u Coffee Mill, where you will be met by your expert guide. After your coffee farm tour and tasting, travel through the remote and rugged landscape of Ka'u – home to Hawaii Volcanoes National Park. Discover how the powerful forces of nature have shaped the people and landscape of this dynamic region, Hawaii's largest land district. The perfect blend of nature and culture led by an expert guide, this tour reveals what it's like to live on two active volcanoes.

Lunch at Volcano House Restaurant is served during your adventure before you are met by your helicopter at a nearby ranch, and take to the skies again, for your return flight to Kona.

#### TWILIGHT VOLCANO ADVENTURE

Witness the magic of Kilauea as we explore the island's incredible range of ecosystems and climate zones before experiencing first-hand the phenomena that makes it possible – an erupting volcano. Working our way across the island, we'll take in sites along the Saddle Road, home to some of the rarest ecosystems in the world.

Upon arriving at Hawaii Volcanoes National Park, we'll explore the natural wonders of this World Heritage site. The summit caldera, steam vents, cinder fields, and native rainforests are all on our 'must see' list. In addition, we'll include stops at the Jaggar Museum, the Visitor Centre and Kilauea Iki.

As conditions change daily, we tailor your experience to the current eruptive events. After exploring the natural wonders of this World Heritage site, we'll check current conditions to see where the best possible viewing of the eruption site is most active. Our choice may require us to leave the park to locate possible breakout flows from the Pu'u O'o Vent or the Halemaumau Crater which contains a hidden lake of molten rock that glows after dark.

#### MANTA NIGHT SNORKEL

Ever dreamt of observing these gentle giants while they feed on plankton? It is an awesome experience! The Kona Coast is one of the best places in the world to get up close and personal with manta rays. Their huge 12' wingspans and agile movements are truly mesmerizing. With no teeth and no stinger, they are quite harmless.

Just after sunset you will go out on the water for the experience of a lifetime. At night is when the mantas feed on their favourite foods. The vessel has safe lights which attract the plankton and the mantas to feed on it.














#### BLUE SKIES OF O'AHU HELICOPTER TOUR

From the high skies above O'ahu, see the island's stunning hidden valleys and waterfalls only accessible by air. Picturesque views of Pearl Harbour await you, including the USS Arizona Memorial and the battleship Missouri.

Take to the sky and head out over the island of O'ahu to take in famous locations and hidden treasures. Your pilot narrates your flight with fun, interesting facts and local history, using aviation-grade noise-cancelling headsets. Your Eco-Star helicopter provides 180-degree views of all the sights. You might spot surfers catching the breakers as you fly over Honolulu and the famous Waikiki Beach. Stunning views of the Diamond Head crater, Hawaii's most recognized landmark, are yours to appreciate before you continue along the rugged coast to the North Shore. The crescent-shaped Hanauma Bay and white-sand beaches of Waimanalo highlight the landscape. Next, soar into the valleys of the Nu'uanu rainforest to the thundering Sacred Falls. On the return back to the heliport, have your camera ready to take aerial photos of the USS Arizona Memorial and the USS Missouri in Pearl Harbour.
